January 30th Guard show for parents

- Need to get time from Michael and post event on website (**Andy**).

Rehearsathon

- Need to get date for Guard.
- Percussion is February 14, 9-9: lunch is at 12:30, dinner is at 5 with preview performance at 9:30.
- **Patty** to organize pot luck lunch with percussion parents (food will cover dinner too).
- Each percussion member needs to raise \$125 which goes to the general fund of MBPA. Anything raised above that goes into the student's account.
- **Jim** will get envelopes for each percussion member for them to organize collections.

SEMSBA auditions (Laurie)

- At QMS 2/7, 8:45-3:45 (use two shifts of workers: 8-12 and 12-4)
- QMS parents can help but really want this to be run by students; HS Tri M members are helping.
- **Laurie** to ask QMS parents.
- Main thing that needs to be done is sell concessions: **Laurie** and **Matt** will buy concessions and get reimbursed from SEMSBA before 6/1 (SEMSBA deadline).

Home Show

- March 21.
- Will have meeting focused on Home Show on 2/4.
- **Jim** has a binder of information which has the list of volunteers needed and information from prior Home Shows.
- 50/50 raffle: we need to get permission from the town (need to go to town hall).
- Need police.
- **Matt** will look into hiring the HS trainer to help with medical issues. Otherwise, we'll need to hire EMTs.
- **Matt** will lead and delegate volunteer jobs.
- We can use the school cafeteria.
- At this point, we have 25 groups signed up (both percussion and color guard); may go up some.
- **Marybeth** is looking into getting donations of water from Stop & Shop, Rite Aid, etc.
- **Matt** to ask Peter C if he wants to MC the Home Show.
- Ad book:

- Need to have all ads in by March 10.
- We should use the website to keep list of which companies we have asked so that we don't duplicate efforts. **Cheryl** will coordinate and update the list.
- There is a form (in the Home Show binder) that we give to businesses when we solicit.
- We will use art from company business cards as part of ad when possible.
- \$50 for half page ad and \$100 for full page ad; half of ad money goes to student's account.
- **Jim** to look into Allegra printing: maybe they would donate printing in exchange for an ad?
- **Laura Z** could be involved in laying out the ad book.
- We want glossy cover with plain pages inside.
- We should give any extras back to businesses as thank you and so they can see how their ad looked.

Performance Schedules

- **Matt** to put full calendar for bands and color guards on website after Wednesday (1/14)'s NESBA meeting.

\$500 raffle for working at Gillette

- **Jim** has full list of all Gillette workers.
- Each person's name is on the list as many times as they worked.
- **Jim** will number each name on the list and use a random number generator to choose the winner.
- We will do this raffle on 2/4 at the meeting (lots of witnesses)

WGI informational meetings

- Percussion meeting happened already
- Color guard meeting will be 1/29. **Cheryl** will send message to parents.
- Color guard are flying to Dayton; **Matt** needs to get permission from the School Committee.

XFINITY Center fundraising opportunity (Jim)

- Received opportunity to work concert events at \$50 per volunteer per event.
- We need to commit to 10 events.
- Volunteers must be 18+ and 21+ to serve alcohol.
- Since we couldn't use students, this isn't right opportunity for us but **Jim** is going to look into whether individuals could volunteer without MBPA committing.

Talia Kuras outreach fundraiser (Jim)

- Former band member is now in 7th Regiment Drum Core.
- She wrote letter asking if we would help her with her fundraising efforts.
- Although we cannot make a donation, we can add her link to the bottom of a future correspondence to Band Parents asking people individually to help.

Treasurer's Report

- Jim gave itemized listing of all expenditures from August – December, 2014.
- Currently, we have \$19.6K in our bank account with 4 Gillette games and Gillette “hold out money” left to be paid.
- Jim presented percussion and color guard budgets to date; there is \$11.5K unspent to date.
- With 4 payments outstanding on Gillette payments, our net revenues to date for Gillette are \$9K (\$15K gross revenues net of payouts to student accounts of \$6K).
- **Jim** will talk about laddering CDs in next meeting.

Miscellaneous

- **Jim** to ask **Andy** if he enhanced website. Jim has not received any bills for enhancement.
- Matt will be spending \$3,500 for mallets, etc and \$350 for software (from percussion budget).
- Any adult chaperones going to Dayton should book their own hotel rooms (Hampton Inn in Springfield).
- Concert for all bands (QMS and MHS) will be held on March 19.
- Matt wants to buy a tympani throne for \$280 for band: all voted in favor.
- Matt wants to buy trash cans, buckets for new band for March 19 concert; cost about \$300: all voted in favor; **Marybeth** said she may be able to get cheaper cans (based on experience with boy scouts).
- Matt knows that the Band Parent organizations in Dartmouth, KP, Reading and Blackstone have revenues of \$50K. He encouraged us to reach out to these organizations to learn what they do to fundraise.
- Next year Matt will be introducing “Smart Music” to Mansfield. This is at home coaching, online instruction which costs \$40/year. Requires a \$140 director’s license.
- In the Fall, Matt plans on bringing the marching band to 2 band festivals to get them connected with the larger band community.
- There will be a big recruitment efforts at QMS and elementary schools next year.
- Mina Conan from Norton wants to learn about our organization and how it works. **Matt** will reach out to her.
- Laura Z told us that the color guard was told on Sunday that they’d need \$155 for uniforms.
