- We have around \$16,000.00 in the bank, \$15,000.00 after bills (not including student credits), and around \$22,000.00 once all our owed money is paid to us.

Notes from President

- The board met with the mattress coordinator Jack Isaacs before this meeting. He handed us a check for \$3085.00. Great job to everyone by advertising with lawn signs, passing out flyers to friends, family, teachers, neighbors, and even at the train station!! We did a great job as a team promoting this fundraiser, so kudos to all of you for getting us a little over \$3000.00 for your music program!! The board will meet with Jack next year in late May to plan a kick off meeting for our next mattress sale which is already scheduled for the last day of band camp.
- We have renewed our annual insurance plan on August 18th., thanks to Mark Horowitz. The cost was \$318.00 which includes general liability for a \$1M/\$2M, Directors and Officers \$1M, and Accidental Medical \$50k.
