Notes from Treasurer's Report

- We ended the month of September with a cash balance of \$20,606.14. Although with some revenues coming in and expenses we will have a balance of \$23,706.58 as of 10/1..
- Waiting to get paid \$14,000.00 from Gillette which includes events from August – present. Once we have those paid and put aside student credits (around \$8900.000) we will have around \$26000.00 available.

Notes from Band Director

- Big E went really well this year. The kids looked forward to it, and had a great time bonding with each other. They also had a great experience performing as a group together for the first time this year.
- As far as the marching band goes, the season is almost over. We have had 2 games already and only a couple more to go. We are thinking ahead to plan our marching band banquet. We are tentatively planning it for Friday, November 18th In the High School Cafeteria. Details and confirmation will be announced.
- The Dayton trip was approved by the school committee for the percussion. We will be going during April vacation. These dates are April 20-23rd in Dayton, OH. A meeting with details regarding this will be held the week of October 17th. Watch for updates.
- New budget was discussed for the band and color guards winter/spring season. We will be in need of another \$10,000.00.

Notes from President

- Siobhan McDonald is taking care of helping us apply for a grant through the Cultural Council. This grant we are hoping will pay for the Home Show judges and the Big E bus fee. Thank you for doing this Siobhan!
- According to Mark Horowitz we are fully insured. We have renewed our annual insurance plan on August 18th . The cost was \$318.00 which includes general liability for a \$1M/\$2M, Directors and Officers \$1M, and Accidental Medical \$50k.
