### **Treasurer Update:**

### Secretary Update:

- Gillette- We just received a large check from Gillette for our September events. They have been really good about paying us this year. We are only waiting to be paid for 2 events as of right now. We have 4 scheduled events left. One high school super bowl all day event that is full with 13 volunteers. This is an all day event, but will be receiving \$75 credit for their shift. Other events that are left are football games. Looking for 7 more people for each as well as some hot chocolate fill ins. Can not have students on December 2nd, as it is a school night.
- Marching Band Banquet will be held on Sunday, December 9th in the high school cafeteria from 6:00pm to 9:00pm. A sign up genius has been put together for a potluck celebration. Decorations will include lanterns from this years show and posters of this 23 seniors.

### Fundraising Update:

- **Comedy Night-** This was a super fun night. We made \$3020.00 from raffle, tickets and wine pull. Thank you to everyone who helped put it all together. It was a group effort.
- **Apparel Orders-** Ink'd items have been successful. We made \$615 profit in Marching Band 2018 orders, \$165 in tie-dye band camp t-shirt orders, and \$126 in Marching Band hats from Grogan Marciano.
- **Glass/Ornaments-** Kim O'Neill has had over \$400 in custom orders . She can also set up a table at the Jordan Jackson conferences, but she will need some help. She also got an order from the football gridiron club for candy jars for their banquet.
- **Yankee Candle-** online sales is still ongoing and will be until January 9th, 2019. Catalog sales have been closed. We have sold \$682.00 online, which means we have made \$272.00 in profits so far.
- **Scripts-** has been a great fundraiser through Mary Dalton. Our October order brought us in \$280.00 in profits. The next order dates coming up are November 13th and December 10th.
- **Restaurant Fundraising-** We have received 3 checks for the last couple months. We got \$184 from the 99, \$60.00 from Orange Leaf, and \$550.00 from Bertucci's.
- **Amazon Smile- is available every time you order from Amazon. This year it was around \$38. We can always raise more when Amazon offers special giving days which gives us double points.**
